Day 1 - Rio De Janeiro

Arrive Rio. Transfer to Hotel. Afternoon, tour to the 2,460 ft high mountain peak of Corcovado, located at Floresta da Tijuca. From the Cristo Redentor, one of the New 7 Wonders of the world and Rio's most famous landmark statue enjoy a panoramic view of the city. Then visit the Botanical Garden and the South District Beaches.

Day 2 - Rio Tours and Sugarloaf Mountain

Morning city tour including the Sugar Loaf. Visit to the famous soccer stadium, Maracana and historical downtown. Arrive at Urca neighborhood and embark in the cable-car up to the "Pan de Azucar". Nice view of the city and mountains chain. **Lunch at hotel.**

Dinner and show at Plataforma – Experience the lights, colors and music of Brazil

Day 3 – Rio De Janeiro/Igaussu

After breakfast, transfer to the Airport for the flight to Iguassu. Upon arrival, transfer to Esturion Hotel. Immediate visit to the Brazilian side of the falls. Enjoying the magnificent panorama of Waterfalls. The spectacle of this 2 mile wide torrential downpour with some cataracts as high as 250 feet is nothing short of hypnotic. The clouds of spray, the incessant roar, and the surrounding luxuriant tropical growth make this an unforgettable natural wonder.

Day 4 – Iguassu Falls

After breakfast, this morning visit to the Falls National Park in the Argentinean side including the San Martin Falls and the Devil's Throat. **Lunch** at local restaurant in the park.

Day 5 – Iguassu/Buenos Aires

Transfer to the airport to board the flight to Buenos Aires. Upon arrival transfer to Nogaro Hotel. Rest of the day at leisure depends upon the time of arrival.

Day 6 – Buenos Aires

Buffet breakfast

Full day sightseeing tour of Buenos Aires: “Plaza de Mayo”, the Government Palace (Pink House), the Cathedral, the City Hall, San Telmo, -where the city was founded 425 years ago-, Puerto Madero, a remodeled neighborhood from the 19th century which has become the most exclusive residential area today; La Boca, where tango was born, La Recoleta, the high class residential area and Palermo, with wonderful parks and avenues. **Lunch at local restaurant and Dinner.**

Day 7 – Buenos Aires/Lima

Buffet breakfast

Transfer to the airport on time for the flight to Lima Peru. Arrival, reception and transfer to hotel Casa Andina Classic. Overnight.

Day 8 - Lima

Buffet breakfast

City tour of Lima featuring the visit to the Larco Museum, then San Francisco Convent and the Cathedral (Cathedral closed). San Francisco, the greatest monumental complex of colonial art in America. We will see the basilica with 21 altars, convent with cloister and clementina and capitular rooms, choir and monks library, and the Museo de Profundis that has 111 canvases from Rubens School. We will also see the Sacristy, with canvas of Zurbarán and Rivera, Gran Patio Ornamented with XVI century tiles from Sevilla, Moris arcs and finally underground catacombs. Historic center - Paseo de la República,

San Martín Square, main square, Government Palace, City Hall and old streets with colonial mansions and moris balcones.

Dinner at Mantra restaurant (set menu) round trip transfers

Day 9 – Lima/Cusco/Urubamba

Light breakfast (coffee+bread+butter+edam cheese+fruit juice+yogourt)

05:30 Transfer to the airport

07:45 Departure flight to Cusco (3,400 m.a.s.l.)

09:00 Upon arrival, transportation to the Sacred Valley of Urubamba at 2,900 m.a.s.l.

On the way visit Awanacancha (Peruvian camelids farm), the indian market of Pisac and the fortress of Ollantaytambo **Buffet lunch at Rtunupa Restaurant; Dinner** at La Casona hotel

Accommodations: La Casona De Yucay Hotel



Day 10 – Urubamba/Machu Picchu

09:45 Transfer to the train station in Ollanta

11:25 Departure on IncaRail executive train to Aguas Calientes

13:39 Arrival and bus to the Lost City of Machu Picchu (2,390 m.a.s.l.) citadel.

Buffet lunch at Sanctuary restaurant

Guided tour of the ruins.

19:38 Departure of the train back to Ollanta station

21:40 Arrival and bus transportation to Hotel in Yucay

Dinner and overnight at La Casona de Yucay hotel

Day 11 – Urubamba/Cusco

Buffet breakfast

09:30 Full day tour to the salines of Maras and the ruins of Moray

Buffet lunch at Allpamanka restaurant in the Valley

Afternoon return to Cusco to CASA ANDINA CLASSIC hotel

Dinner at Maikhana restaurant (on foot)

14:00 Walking tour visiting the Koricancha Temple of the Sun God, stroll around the Main Plaza and visit the Cathedral.

09:00 Excursion by boat to the floating Uros Islands. These islands are completely man-made structures and their inhabitants, the uros, continue to maintain them as they have since Precolumbian times, using totora reeds from the lake to build not only the islands but also their houses.

12:30 **Lunch** at local restaurant

14:00 Excursion to Sillustani ruins on the shores of Umayo Lake

19:00 Pick up from LarcoMar and transfer to **Mantra restaurant for dinner**

21:00 Transfer back to the airport
